Elvis Mardini of Sydney-based Mardini Constructions explains how to get the best out of your builder:

Communication is crucial, sometimes we end up spending 12 to 18 months on a house, so we get to know our clients well. I think you have to have a good relationship for the build to go as smoothly as possible.

Honesty is vital, too. I tell it like it is, only because I want the best outcome for the job. For most people, building a home is one of the most significant things they'll ever do. That's why builders need to be respectful of the owner's wishes and to approach their work with integrity.

Weekly meetings are a good way to stay on top of what's going on. I hold a meeting on-site once a week. This ensures that if any issues crop up they're immediately resolved before they become a big problem.

4 It's so much better if homeowners begin a project knowing what they want. There is usually room to vary your plans but the more you do this, the higher the risk of blowing your budget. A little bit of planning will go a long way.

5 Being on top of your budget is fundamental. A lot of people decide on a \$20,000 kitchen and then see a \$50,000 one and suddenly have to have it — but you need to be realistic. If you can't afford it, don't do it — better to not go there than to end your marriage.
